Language Area

We will be making crafts and projects that use this month's sounds. The Chinese sounds will be ㄆ, ㄑ, ㄒ, and ㄓ (rr, dz, ts and shr). We will continue on reading the Chinese poem 放鞭炮 (Fang Bien Pao). We will learn about the Construction Boxes and will work with the Five Boxes to see what we can make with them. These boxes teach about shapes and how to use them to build things.



Math Area

Younger children will continue with qualities of each number. They will do this while learning how to trace numbers and recognize written numbers. Older children will be working on place value and simple addition. We will also work with carrying over and borrowing unit, tens, hundreds and thousand. We will also work with the subtraction board and continue with telling time.

Practical Life Area

We will work with using spoons, using tongs, and pouring water. We will still work with pushing in chairs, putting work away in the right place, and will work on lacing and bow frames and buttoning jackets. We will also work with polishing shoes, sifting, lading, washing babies, and I Spy.
