Language Area

MathArea

This month, we will learn the numbers zero to nine. We will also work with color stairs to help in understanding these numbers and their corresponding color. We will work on telling the time, the spindle box, and tracing numbers and lines. Older children will begin learning tens using a ten-board and beads and will work with this month's calendar.

Practical Life Area
