## Art and Music

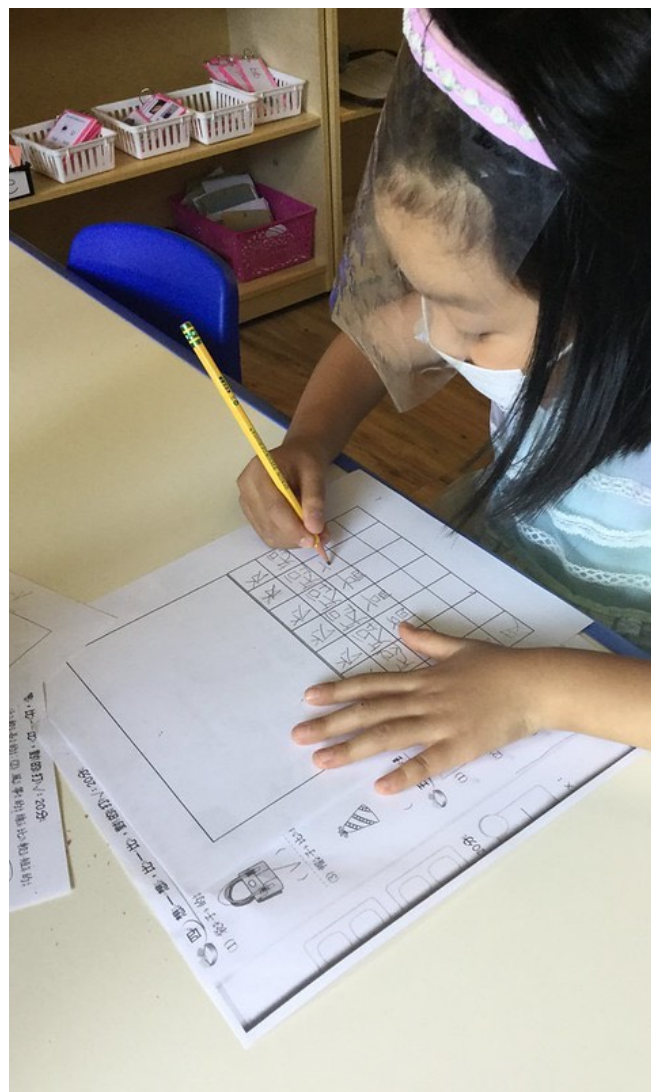

## Sensorial Area

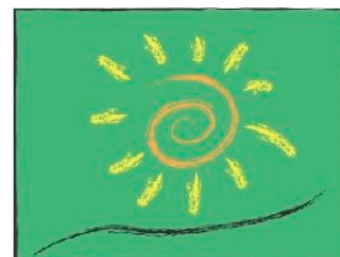
This month, We will work with material color tablets box 1-2, cylinder blocks and geometric solids so they will be learning about colors and shapes and some worksheets.

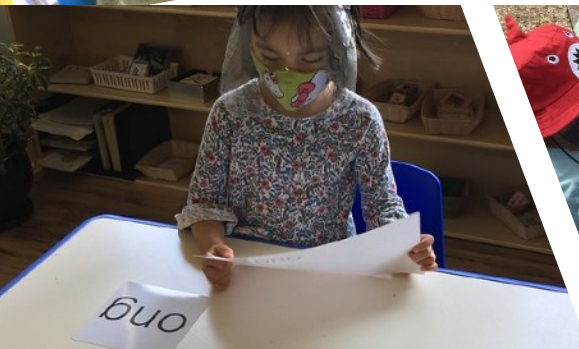
## Math Area

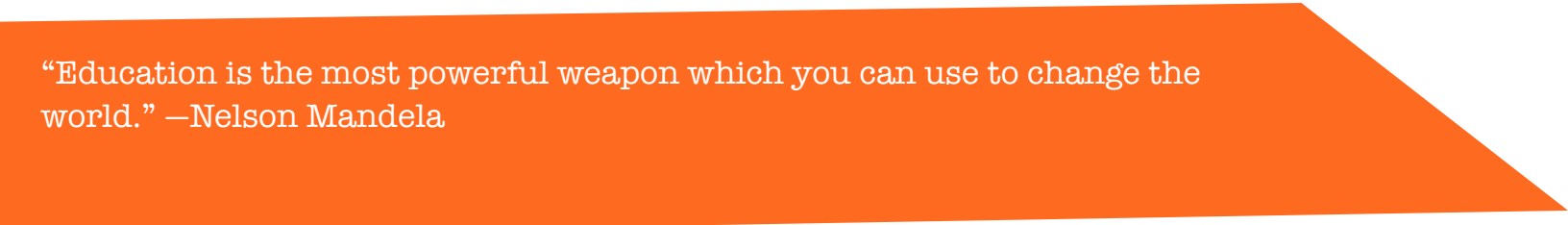
## Practical Life Area
